

Welcome to MyUofMHealth Bedside

MyUofMHealth Bedside is a tool to keep you informed and engaged during your hospital stay. It is only available for patients admitted to the adult hospitals and the adult and pediatric (child) emergency rooms.

Use the MyUofMHealth Bedside mobile app to:

- Learn about your diagnosis, medications, and hospital safety.
- Review your test results.
- See the doctors, nurses, and other providers on your care team.
- See your upcoming schedule of tests, procedures, and therapies.
- Answer questions to help your care team give you personalized care.
- Invite your family or friends to see your medical record (called **proxy access**) and participate in your care.
- Stay up-to-date on your healthcare with alerts and messages sent to your phone (make sure to turn notifications on).

How do I access MyUofMHealth Bedside?

MyUofMHealth Bedside is available through the MyUofMHealth mobile app. If you already have the MyUofMHealth app, the Bedside features will show on the screen when you log in. MyUofMHealth Bedside is only available through the mobile app and not through the web browser version of the patient portal.

How do I download the MyUofMHealth patient portal mobile app?

Search for the MyUofMHealth app in the Apple App Store or Google Play store to download for free.

How do I sign up for a MyUofMHealth patient portal account?

From the MyUofMHealth mobile app, click on “Sign up.”

Can I use the MyChart app to access MyUofMHealth Bedside?

Yes. If you already have the MyChart app, you can access MyUofMHealth Bedside from there. Select “Add Organization” and search for “University of Michigan Health.” Follow the instructions to create an account.

How do I give my family or friends access to see information in MyUofMHealth Bedside?

If you already have an account:	If you do not have an account:
1. Log in to your account from the MyUofMHealth mobile app. 2. Go to “Your Menu” and select “Sharing Hub.” 3. Scroll down to “Give Friends and Family Access” and follow the instructions.	1. From the MyUofMHealth mobile app, click “Sign up.” 2. Select “No Activation Code? Sign Up Online.” 3. Select “Adult patient requesting family/friend to have access to my chart” and follow the instructions.

Note: Giving your family or friends access to MyUofMHealth Bedside will also let them see your medical record, including information for more than just your current hospital stay.
